- Monitors batch extraction processes, including taking samples

- Calibrates and sets up equipment prior to use.
- Uses initiative and judgment in applying standard operating procedures.
- Participates as a team member in identifying and implementing continuous improvement opportunities within the plant.
- Follows all quality system protocols and reports any discrepancies to the Supervisor.
- Understands and abides by applicable government regulations (e.g. Transportation of Dangerous Goods (TDG) and Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS)).
